# ABOUT

This 700-acre, scenic, natural area is organized around a complex of small canyons with rugged topography and offers miles of marked and well-maintained hiking trails. Abundant with rich biological resources and aquatic corridors, the preserve offers a wide range of habitats for various plants and wildlife.

Along the trails, hikers will discover natural, cultural, and archeological features – including scenic overlooks, waterfalls, rich wildflower areas, creek cascades, boulder fields, Native American rock shelters, pioneer cabin sites, and more. Popular hikes include a short walk to an unforgettable canyon overlook and a moderately challenging trail with an elevation change of around 350 feet from the ridge top to the creek level.

Jim and Faye Lacefield purchased a 40-acre plot in 1979 and gradually expanded their property over the years, creating a trail system to share the area's unique natural beauty with others. After many years as caretakers, they generously donated Cane Creek Canyon to the Land Trust of North Alabama in February 2023 to ensure its future protection and continued public access.
